All winners will be recognized by ASA North Texas in the multimedia presentation, printed program and ASA Website and a press release for Award winners will be distributed to construction-related media outlets. JUDGING

Your submissions are judged by a panel of three distinguished judges. They will be sent a short survey in which they will rank your performance on a scale of 1-10 in the following categories below.

Please submit 10 photos to be included in the marketing material for the event. Also provide a FOUR sentence summary of the project. Pictures must include works in progress and completion photos. All photos may be submitted electronically to <u>awards@asa-northtexas.org</u>. Applicants will receive a video of the project for your own use, we will post video on our YouTube site.
